



SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

(January 2016)

We believe that a school uniform is important:

- It looks smart
- Wears well
- Contributes to a sense of belonging
- Gives a common purpose
- Fosters a feeling of pride

We ask that all children wear the uniform and we encourage them to maintain a good standard of clean and tidy dress in school.

Our school colours are blue and grey.

Our school uniform is as follows:

Boys:

Trousers - Grey or Black
Pullover/Sweatshirt - Navy blue
Shirt - Grey or White
Tie - Maroon

Girls :

Skirt/Tunic - Navy Blue
Cardigan/Sweatshirt - Navy Blue
Blouse - White
Tie - Maroon

Hair accessories such as slides, ribbons, bobbles etc. should be fairly simple and if possible in school colours.

Parents are asked to ensure that all items are labelled clearly with their child's name.

For safety reasons we ask that the children do not wear jewellery in school. This includes earrings only studs may be worn.

PE Kit

For health and safety reasons it is important that children are properly dressed for any physical activity.

Our uniform for PE is as follows:

T shirt
Shorts
Pumps

Tracksuits can be worn in winter times
and poor weather

PE kit should be kept in a named drawstring bag or safe bag, not a polythene bag.

PE kit should be kept in school and returned home for washing at weekends and holidays. All items of PE clothing should be named.
