| After school/holiday clubs | The after school and holiday clubs provided children with the opportunity to develop their skills further and allowed children to exercise outside the curriculum requirements. Subsiding the holiday courses has allowed more children to take up the opportunity to be active during the half term holidays. | £1,500 |
| | Fun club run across KS2 also provided an extra opportunity for children to be active during term times. | |
| Training for staff | We had a highly qualified sports coach for the year to model PE lessons for the Year 5 staff. This has improved their confidence and ability in delivering a range higher quality PE lessons. | £6,000 |
| Spare PE kit | Spare PE kits allowed every child to participate in every PE lesson, raising participation across the whole school. | £200 |
| Equipment | Buying new and replacing worn equipment ensures all PE lessons are delivered safely and to the full enjoyment of all children. | £300 |
| Awards/rewards | This provides children with extra motivation within lessons. These rewards are for participation during the school year. Awards include sports day, sports person of the year and sports stars. | £500 |
| Curriculum enrichment days | This provides the children the opportunity to experience different activities that school cannot provide. | £250/300 per session (approx.) |
