Use	Impact	Amount
After school/holiday clubs	<p>The after school and holiday clubs provided children with the opportunity to develop their skills further and allowed children to exercise outside the curriculum requirements.</p> <p>Subsidising the holiday courses has allowed more children to take up the opportunity to be active during the half term holidays.</p> <p>Fun club run across KS1 and KS2 which provided an extra opportunity for children to be active during term times and to participate in a range of games not taught in the curriculum.</p>	£1,500
Training for staff	<p>We hired a highly qualified sports coach for the year to model PE lessons for the Year 1 staff. This has improved their confidence and ability in delivering a range higher quality PE lessons. Audits were taken before and after to show an increase in staff confidence.</p>	£6,000
Spare PE kit	<p>Spare PE kits allowed every child to participate in every PE lesson, raising participation across the whole school.</p>	£200
Equipment	<p>Buying new and replacing worn equipment ensures all PE lessons are delivered safely and to the full enjoyment of all children.</p>	£300
Awards/rewards	<p>This provides children with extra motivation within lessons. These rewards are for participation during the school year. Awards include sports day, sports person of the year and sports stars.</p>	£500
Curriculum enrichment days	<p>This provides the children the opportunity to experience different activities that school cannot provide.</p>	£250/300 per session (approx.)
