Maths Targets

I can add multiples of 10 to any number (e.g. $37 + 20$)

I can recall multiplication and division facts for 10s e.g. $3 \times 10 = 30$
 $30 \div 10 = 3$

I can subtract multiples of 10 from any number e.g. $34 - 20 = 14$

I can take away a small number by counting back

I can find a small difference by counting up from the smaller number to the larger number (on a numberline)

I can count in steps of 10 from a given number forward and backwards from 0
