Children are brought onto the playground in readiness for their collection times.

- 3pm** **Infant Families – children in years 1 and 2 only**
- 3:10pm** **Infant AND junior families**
- 3:20pm** **Junior families only – children in years 3, 4, 5 and 6 only**

As the children are brought out onto the playground at the correct times, if you are collecting a child for another family, you **MUST** contact the school office to inform us. This will enable us to get the children ready for you.

P.E. Days

From Monday 7th, pupils will start P.E. lessons and should come to school in their P.E. clothing on their P.E. day. Pupils should wear a pair of leggings or plain tracksuit bottoms and their P.E. coloured t-shirt. If it is warmer, children can wear shorts.
